Alzheimer's Disease	Develop individualized plan of care; Identify caregiver knowledge deficits and support system needed; Monitor for healthy diet and exercise; Provided resources.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
CHF	Assess patient for risk factors; Develop individualized plan of care; Instruct patient on disease process, diet/fluid restrictions, medications, and how to monitor/record weight.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
COPD	Comprehensive assessment for risk factors; Develop individualized plan of care; Instruct patient on disease pathophysiology/worsening symptoms.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Diabetes	Assess patient for risk factors; Develop individualized plan of care; Instruct patient on disease process, dietary management, medications, proper foot care, and how to monitor blood glucose and when to take action.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Falls Prevention	Assess patient for risk factors; Develop individualized plan of care; Home safety assessment; Instruct patient on medications, exercise program, nutrition/hydration, safe transfers/mobility, and proper use of assistive devices.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Hypertension	Assess patient's knowledge of disease process and its associated care and treatment; Develop individualized plan of care; Instruct patient on proper technique for daily blood pressure monitoring, and importance of balanced diet and adherence to dietary restrictions.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Parkinson's	Develop individualized plan of care; Identify caregiver knowledge deficits; Identify support system needs; Instruct on Parkinson's disease progression; Reduce anxiety and depression through appropriate caregiver responses; Assist caregiver with medication management;	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Stroke & TBI	Develop individualized plan of care; Teach caregiver/patient how to live with effects of stroke; Educate on lifestyle changes to prevent additional stroke; Monitor for fall prevention/safety in the home.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Light Step	Develop individualized plan of care; Assess for pain and poor circulation; Monitor for healthy diet and exercise; Instruct patient how to reduce the risk of falls and help manage pain.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources

Behavioral Health at Home	Conduct weekly visits; Provide education and support for family members & patient 24/7; Instruct patient on medications, disease process, coping skills, and safe interventions that enhance the patient's independence and safety in the home; Work in coordination with doctor.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Care Connections Pre-Palliative Care	Treat patient's pain and symptoms associated with palliative care diagnoses; Help patient maintain the most comfortable, independent and active lifestyle possible in their home surrounding; Provide answers, assistance and emotional support to patient and family when making difficult medical and life decisions; Identify support services available to you in your community.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Anxiety & Depression	Educate patient and family about medications, diagnosis and coping skills; Assess/Handle complications in a timely manner to prevent exacerbations; Monitor medication compliance; On-Call 24/7 support to patient/family; Instruct on ways to incorporate community resources for support.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Take a Breath	Develop individualized plan of care; Identify symptoms that are expected with COPD; Avoid potential triggers; Instruct patient on medications, understand the proper use of inhalers, nebulizers and oxygen; Instruct on ways to manage breathing, conserve energy and develop healthy lifestyle changes and eating habits.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Pain Management	Educate patient about definition of pain, different types of pain and possible causes; The use of a pain rating scale; How to track pain; How to set and achieve realistic goals for pain control; How to use analgesic pain medications; Use of non-drug therapies to control pain; What to do if pain is not adequately controlled.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
Alzheimer's & Dementia	Teach communication strategies and environmental modifications to Caregivers to reduce/prevent problematic behaviors; Identify personalized nonpharmalogical interventions to treat the patient's behavior; Eduate Car-givers about medications and disease processes.	-Skilled Nursing -Therapies if needed -Social Worker for resources
