A team approach

And our outpatient program helps patients receive state-of-the-art care during the day while returning home for an independent lifestyle. Our on-site medical director leads a highly qualified, multidisciplinary team of nurses and therapists to

provide a coordinated program of rehabilitative care. Our team approach includes rehabilitation experts from the following disciplines:

Case management

Coordinates with the physician to ensure the patient's needs are met and involves the family and other caregivers in the patient's rehabilitation.

Dietary and nutritional counseling

Supervises all meals to ensure patients meet their required nutritional needs.

Occupational therapy

Designs and delivers activity-based therapy to promote independence in the areas of self-care, home management and community reintegration.

Physical therapy

Evaluates and designs a treatment program to address limitations in physical function, mobility and safety.

Psychology

Provides supportive services to assist the patient and family in adjusting to their disability.

Rehabilitation nursing

Implements each patient's medical care program as directed by his or her physician.

Respiratory therapy

Ensures proper respiratory function through services such as oxygen supplements and aerosol treatments.

Speech-language pathology

Assesses and treats individuals with communication and comprehension disorders, cognitive difficulties and swallowing disorders.
